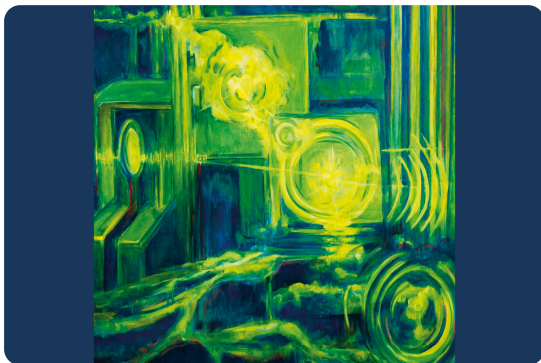

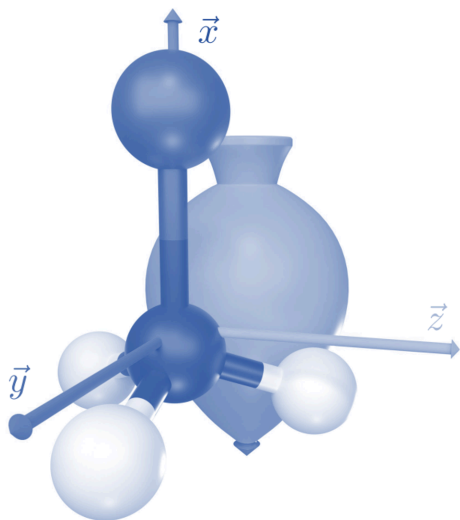
Quantum sensation

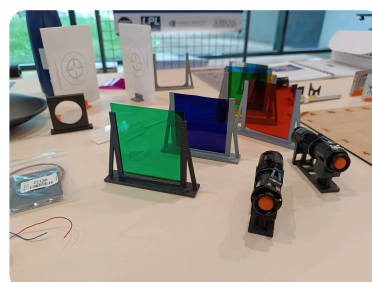
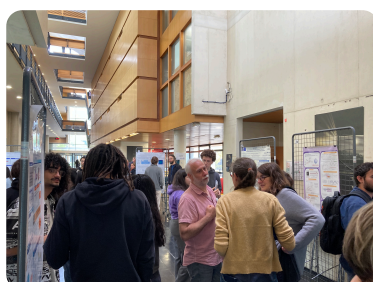
Workshop : Quantum control of rotational dynamics

 Sorbonne University

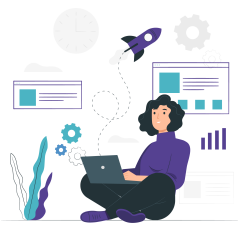
 The workshop will be the opportunity to discuss recent advances, both from the theoretical and the experimental point of view, on the control of quantum systems modeling molecular rotations.
